

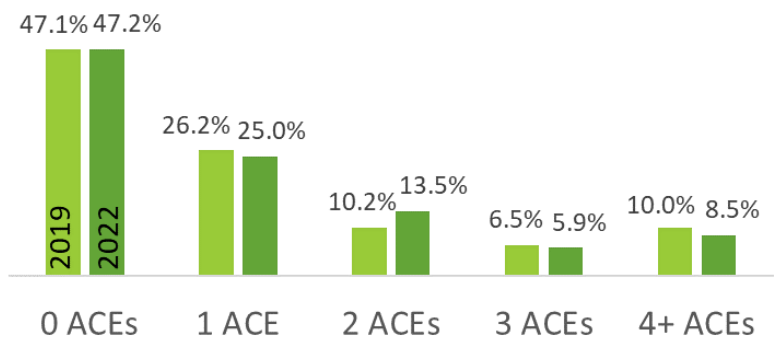

Number of ACEs experienced by students, 2019-2022

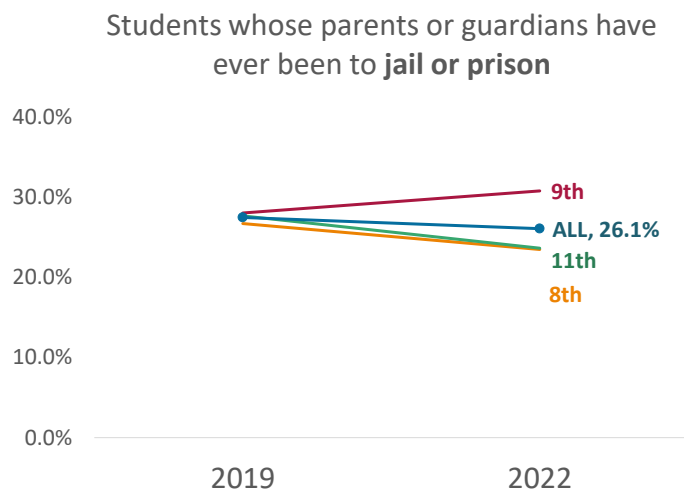

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1 in 4 students surveyed shared that their parent had previously been or is currently incarcerated.

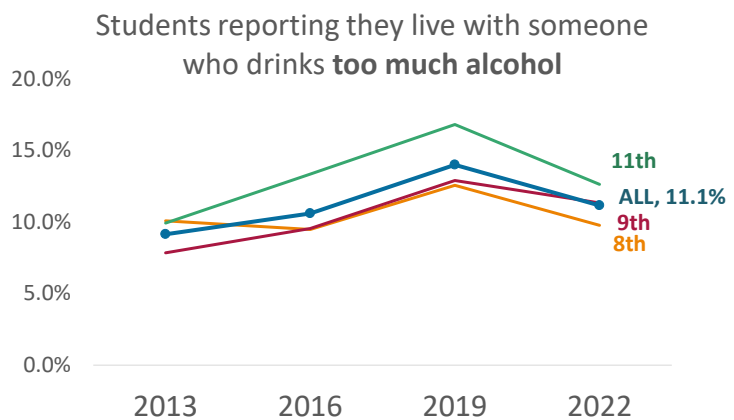

Family substance abuse

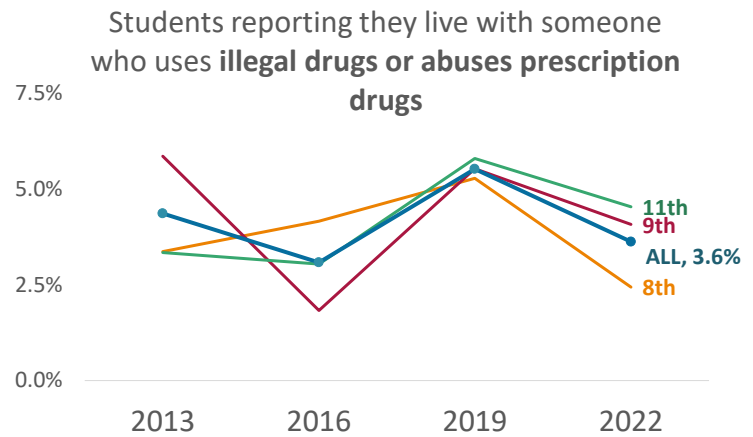
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After increasing since 2013, the percentage of students reporting they live with someone who drinks too much declined from 2019 to 2022.

Since 2019, fewer students in all grades report living with someone who uses drugs.

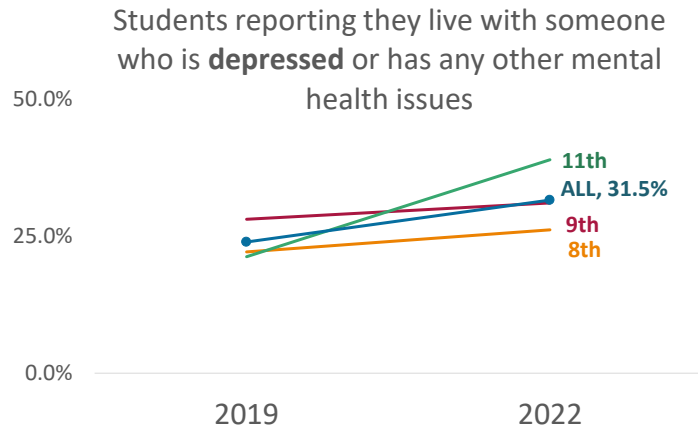

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Nearly 1 in 3 students live with someone with a mental health condition, making this the most common adverse childhood experience.

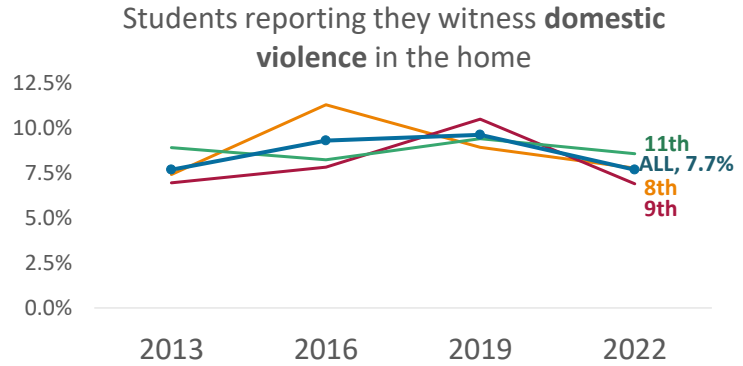

Verbal and physical abuse

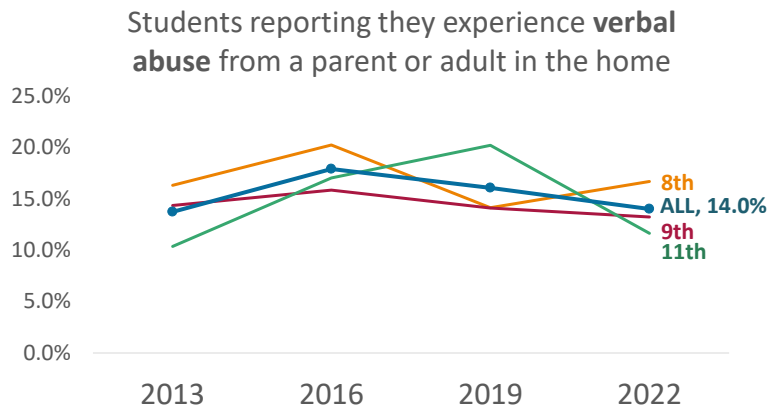

For all grades, students reporting they witnessed domestic violence has declined since 2019.



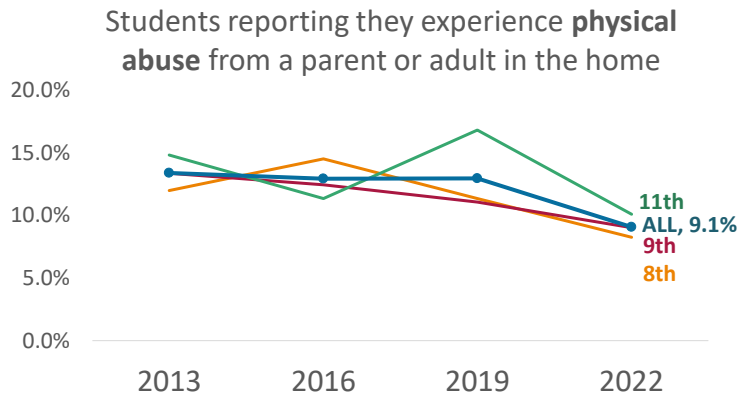
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In 2022, 8th graders report the highest rates of verbal abuse (being sworn at or insulted by parents or adults in the home).



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Nearly 1 in 10 students experiences physical abuse from a parent or adult in the home.

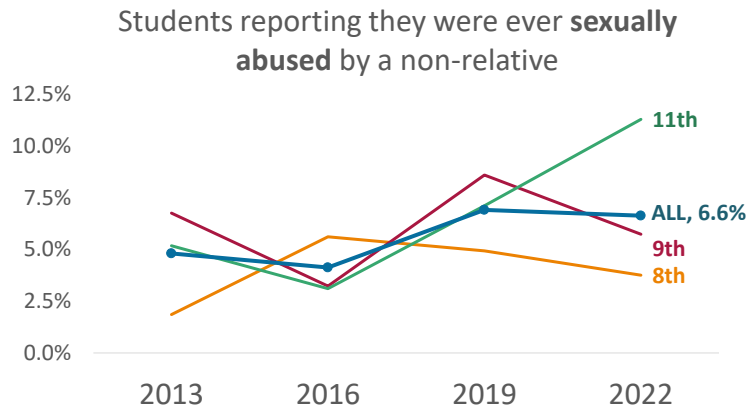


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Sexual abuse and exploitation

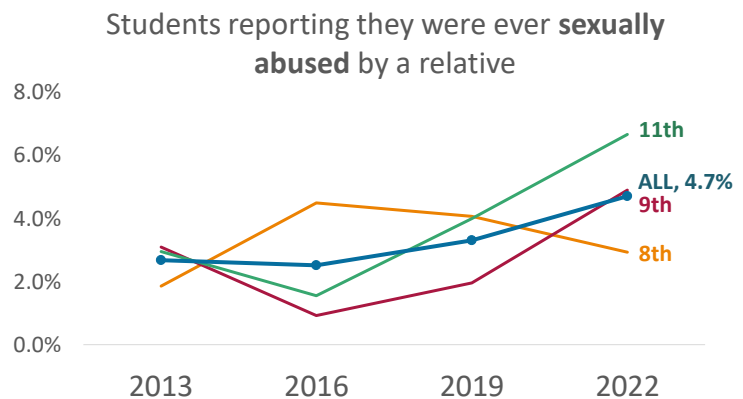
14

11th graders were the most likely to report sexual abuse (ever being pressured, tricked, or forced you to do something sexual or done something sexual to you against your wishes).



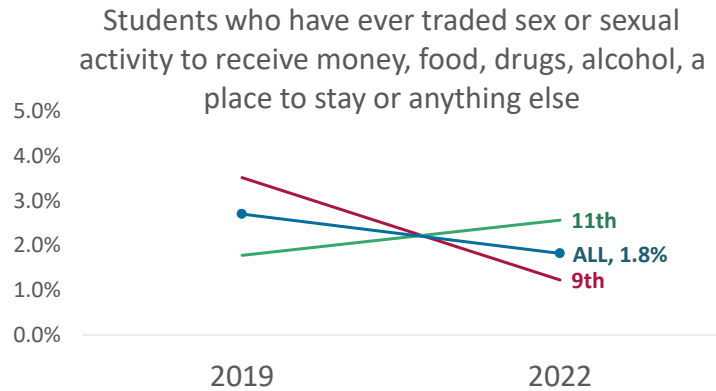

1 in 20 students experiencing sexual abuse at the hands of a relative.



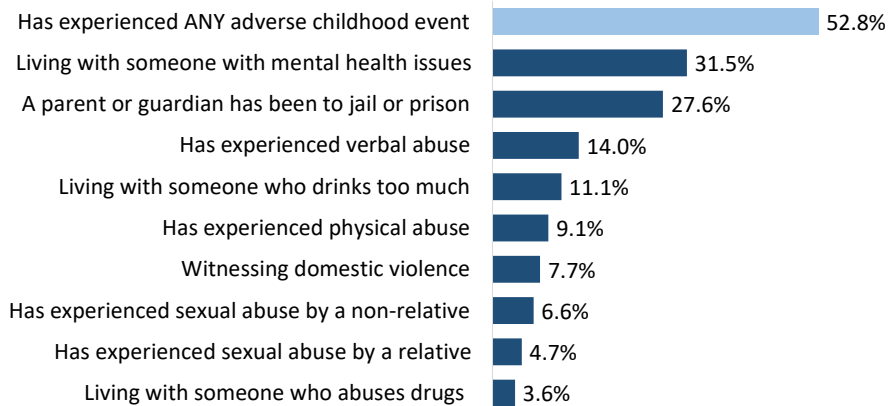
