336 people in Martin County **68** people in Faribault County

received mortgage assistance, rental assistance, transitional housing assistance, and help with move-in costs and/or application fees

We received **176** applications for assistance in Martin County. **80** of those families were approved for assistance

We received **19** applications for assistance in Faribault County. **17** of those families were approved for assistance

ELIGIBILITY



To apply, families must...

- ☒ complete an application that can be picked up at the agency, sent via email, or sent in the mail to be filled out
- ☒ complete an application for emergency assistance using the Combined Application Form found online at MNBenefits or at the agency

Household size, income, affordability of housing, and other factors
determine eligibility and assistance amounts

To be approved, applicants must have a minor child or a pregnancy in the household
